

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Shaping a more successful education

Participation is a way of life in the daycare centres and schools in the district of Soest. Many families have an immigrant background and, like all parents, want their children to develop well and be successful.

The education system is complicated.

The German school system can be very confusing – and not just for parents who are new to Germany! With "Eltern mischen mit – Mitwirken heißt verändern!" we want to actively support parents with a history of immigration and inspire them to get involved in daycare centres and schools – so that they too can get involved. In cooperation with the Elternnetzwerk NRW, we train parent moderators who organise information events for interested parents and inform them about the topic of parental involvement.

The aim of "Eltern mischen mit – Mitwirken heißt verändern!" is to

Encourage parents with a history of immigration to actively support the educational success of their children and to play an active role in the participatory committees of the daycare centres and schools that their children attend.

Qualification

The parent moderators are trained. The training programme is divided into a seminar and a practical phase. The seminars take place on site in the municipalities. The programme comprises a total of 4 days over 2 weekends (32 teaching hours).

How do the parent moderators work?

The parent moderators work in tandem and organise the approximately three-hour information events together. You work with groups of up to 15 participants.



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Venues

The information events take place where the parents are:

- Child day care centres
- Family centres
- Schools
- Parents' cafés
- Refugee centres
- Mosques and churches
- Migrant organisations and other meeting places
